Being part of our help rota will enable you as a parent, grandparent or carer to experience a Pre-School session. As always, please speak with Mr Murrell if you require any further information.

Value to you!

- It allows you to gain a view of your child's involvement and also their enjoyment within the Pre-School environment.
- Parents, grandparents or carers who help in the group get to know what goes on and are in the best position to pick up on Pre-School learning at home.
- Watching your own child busy among the Pre-School activities and getting on with other children can give you a new insight into children's needs and abilities.

Value to children!

- Seeing a parent, grandparent or carer involved in the Pre-School shows children that you value the Pre-School experience – and that they have a part to play in it.
- Children in Pre-School encounter contact with a wider range of adults, each with their own different skills and background, this encourages the children to communicate to those less familiar with them.

What you will do

During this time you will be able to give the staff a little extra help with some of their daily tasks! For example, assisting with daily activities such as snack time, free play, setting up or clearing away the children's resources are just some of the things you can help with.

If you have a special skill or a chosen activity suitable for Pre-School we would value and use that.

How it works

If you would like to take part please fill in the parent help rota which is on the table with the signing in sheet in the main hall. The slots are allocated for a full morning session. However, if you not able to attended for a full session we are happy for you to stay for as long as you can.
